FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

11 April – **St Stanislaus of Krakow** (1030-79) According to tradition St Stanislaus of Krakow was martyred by King Boleslaus II and is the patron saint of Poland. He is also venerated in Lithuania, Belarus and Ukraine.

13 April **Pope St Martin I** (- 655) was born in Todi in Umbria and elected Pope in 649. He called a synod to combat the Monothelite heresy concerning the nature of Christ. One of the people whose teachings were condemned was supported by the Byzantine Emperor, who in 653 had Martin kidnapped from Rome, taken to Constantinople, imprisoned and eventually exiled to the Crimea, where he died on 1 September 655.

14 April – **St Benedict Joseph Labr**e 1748-83 was born in Boulogne, France. He lived most of his life as a beggar in Rome. He is the patron saint of tramps and the homeless. 15 April – **St Damian the Leper** (1840-89) along with his brother, joined the Order of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary from Belgium. His brother was due to go as a missionary to Hawaii, but became ill and Damian offered to go in his place. He went to the leper colony on the island of Molokai near Hawaii. There was no cure for leprosy at that time. He contracted the disease and died there. He was canonised by Pope Benedict XVI in 2009. 16 April **St Bernadette Soubirous** (1844 - 1879) was born in 1844 to a destitute family in Lourdes, in France. On 11 February 1858 she went down to the river Gave with her sister and a friend, to look for firewood and bones. There she received the first of a series of visions of the Mother of God which led to Lourdes becoming a place of pilgrimage and healing. In 1866 she became a nun at Nevers, where she died on 16 April 1879. 17 April **St Donan or Donnan**, came from Ireland and established a monastery on the Isle of Eigg in the Inner Hebrides. On Easter Sunday 617 he and his 52 companions were celebrating Mass when Danish pirates arrived. The pirates allowed them to finish the Mass

Devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of St Faustina Kowalska (1905 - 1938), a Polish nun. The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out on us and the world. B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

HOW TO RECITE THE DIVINE MERCY

CHAPLET using the five decades on ordinary Rosary beads:

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. Our Father

3. Hail Mary

4. The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

5. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

6. On the 10 small beads of each decade For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. 7. Repeat for the remaining decades Saying the "Eternal Father" (5) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (6) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

8. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times) -

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
