FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

16 April **St Bernadette** (1844-1879) was born in Lourdes, France. Her parents were very poor and she was the first of nine children. In 1858 a lady wearing blue and white appeared to 14 year old Bernadette and made the sign of the cross with a rosary of ivory and gold.

18 April **Blessed Marie Anne Blondin** (1809-1890) was a Canadian teacher who founded the Sisters of Saint Anne, dedicated to teaching in the rural areas of Canada.

20 April **Sts Marcellinus, Vincent & Dominus** (- 374) African missionaries to France
21 April **St Anselm of Canterbury** (1033-1109) was a Benedictine monk and abbot who was one of the most important Christian thinkers of the eleventh century.
