### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

**13 Aug: St Fachtna** founded a famous monastic school in Cork. He died in 600.

**14 Aug: St Maximillian Kolbe** (1894-1941) a Polish Franciscan priest who was born in Poland. He died in Auschwitz concentration camp after offering to take the place of a young husband and father who was about to be killed.

**16 Aug: St Stephen of Hungary** (969-1038) became the first King of Hungary in 1001.

**17 Aug:** At 8pm on Thursday 21 Aug 1879 **Our Lady of Knock** appeared at the south gable of the Church at Knock along with St Joseph and St John the Evangelist.
