ST JOHN EUDES, C.J.M. (1601 to 1680) was a French missionary and priest, who founded the Congregation of Jesus and Mary and the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity of the Refuge.

ST BERNARD OF CLAIRVAUX, O.Cist. (1090 to 1153) was a French abbot and the main reformer of the Cistercian order.

POPE SAINT PIUS X, born Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, was Pope from 4 August 1903 to his death in 1914. He was canonized in 1954. The inscription on his tomb reads: "Born poor and humble of heart, Undaunted champion of the Catholic faith, Zealous to restore all things in Christ, Crowned a holy life with a holy death."
