FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

21 Aug: St Pius X (1835- 1914) was born near Venice, and was elected Pope in 1903 against his wishes. He lived in poverty all his life and reformed the liturgy and Canon Law.
23 Aug: St Eugene (618) founded monasteries in Wicklow and Tyrone.
23 Aug: St Rose of Lima (1586-1617) born in Peru, cared for the sick, poor and slaves. She was the first person in the Americas to be canonized & a patron saint of South America.
25 Aug: St Louis (1214-1270) became King of France at the age of 12. He was a prayerful person who was noted for his charity to the poor.
27 Aug: St Monica (331-387) A wonderful example of a Christian mother.
