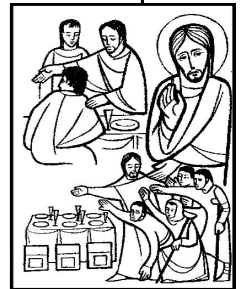

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

28 Aug: St Augustine (354-430) Son of St Monica and a great teacher of the Faith.

29 Aug: The Martyrdom of St John the Baptist - the last prophet of the Old
Testament and the first prophet of the New Testament.

30 Aug: St Fiacre a 7th century priest who founded hermitages in Kilkenny and in France.

31 Aug: St Aidan of Lindisfarne (651) was a monk of Irish descent who founded a
monastery on Lindisfarne. It became the centre of missionary activity in Northern England.

3 Sept: St Gregory the Great (504-604) was a Roman noble who was the first monk to be
elected pope. He sent missionaries to England. Patron saint of musicians.
