### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

31 Aug: **St Aidan** (651) was a monk of Irish descent who founded a monastery on  
Lindisfarne. This became the centre of missionary activity in the North of England.  
3 Sept: **St Gregory the Great** (504-604) was a Roman noble who was the first monk  
to be elected pope. He sent missionaries to England. Patron saint of musicians.  
4 Sept: **St Mac Nissi** (480) Founder and patron saint of the diocese of Connor.  
5 Sept: **Bl. Mother Teresa** (1910 -1997) was a missionary nun from Albania who  
cared for the poor and sick in India. She spent a year in Ireland learning English.
