Pope Gregory I, commonly known as **SAINT GREGORY THE GREAT**, was Pope from
3 September 590 to his death in 604. Gregory is well known for his writings.

SAINT MAC NISSI died 514 was an early Irish bishop-abbot of Antrim. His story as
known is largely legendary. He is said to have been baptized by Saint Patrick.

Oengus Mac Nisse is thought to have been at Kells as a hermit earlier in his life. He
is considered the founder of Kells monastery.
