12 Dec ST FINNIAN (470 to 549) was one of the early Irish monastic saints, who founded Clonard Abbey in modern day Co. Meath. He is the patron saint of the Diocese of Meath. 12 Dec ST JANE FRANCES DE CHANTAL (1572 to 1641) was a French wife, mother, and nun who founded a religious order, the Visitation nuns, after the death of her husband. 13 Dec ST LUCY (281-304) born in Sicily, was killed because of her faith. Patron of the blind 14 Dec St John of the Cross (1542-1501), O.C.D., was a Spanish Carmelite friar, mystic and writer. He was a reformer of the Carmelite Order.
