### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

12 Dec **ST FINNIAN** (470 to 549) was one of the early Irish monastic saints, who founded  
Clonard Abbey in modern day Co. Meath. He is the patron saint of the Diocese of Meath.  
12 Dec **ST JANE FRANCES DE CHANTAL** (1572 to 1641) was a French wife, mother, and nun  
who founded a religious order, the Visitation nuns, after the death of her husband.  
14 Dec **ST JOHN OF THE CROSS** (1542-1501), O.C.D., was a Spanish Carmelite friar, mystic  
and writer. He was a reformer of the Carmelite Order.
