9 Dec **St Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin** (1474-1548) was born in Mexico. In 1531 the Mother of God appeared to him, and told him to have a church built on that spot. 11 Dec **St Damasus I** (304-384) A Spaniard who was elected Pope in 366.

- 12 Dec **St Finnian** (470 to 549) was one of the early Irish monastic saints, who founded Clonard Abbey in modern day Co. Meath. He is the patron saint of the Diocese of Meath.
- 12 Dec **St Jane Frances de Chantal** (1572 to 1641) was a French wife, mother, and nun. 13 Dec **St Lucy** (281-304) born in Sicily, was killed because of her faith. Patron of the blind
- 14 Dec ST JOHN OF THE CROSS (1542-1501), O.C.D., was a Spanish Carmelite friar, mystic
- and writer. He was a reformer of the Carmelite Order.
