BAMBINELLI SUNDAY

Each year on Gaudete Sunday, the Third
Sunday of Advent, children (and adults)

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

9 Dec **ST JUAN DIEGO CUAUHTLATOATZIN** (1474-1548) was born in Mexico. In 1531 the
Mother of God appeared to him, and told him to have a church built on that spot.

11 Dec **ST DAMASUS I** (304-384) A Spaniard who was elected Pope in 366.

12 Dec **ST FINNIAN** (470 to 549) was one of the early Irish monastic saints, who founded
Clonard Abbey in modern day Co. Meath. He is the patron saint of the Diocese of Meath.

12 Dec **ST JANE FRANCES DE CHANTAL** (1572 to 1641) was a French wife, mother, and nun.

13 Dec **ST LUCY** (281-304) born in Sicily, was killed because of her faith. Patron of the blind

14 Dec **ST JOHN OF THE CROSS** (1542-1501), O.C.D., was a Spanish Carmelite friar, mystic
and writer. He was a reformer of the Carmelite Order.
