FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

14 Feb **St Methodius** (826-885) and his brother **St Cyril** (827-869) were born in Greece. They spread the faith in Central Europe and translated liturgical texts into the Slavonic language and invented the Glagolitic and possibly also the Cyrillic alphabet.

14 Feb **St Valentine** (3rd Century) was a Roman Priest at a time when the emperor Claudias persecuted the church and prohibited the marriage of young people. Valentine was imprisoned and tortured for helping young couples to marry.

17 Feb **St Fintan** (524-603) founded a hermitage in Clonenagh, Co. Laois.
