### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

17 Feb **St Fintan** (- 603) studied in Terryglass, Co. Tipperary and later founded his own monastery in Clonenagh, Co. Laois. He died in 603.

21 Feb **St Peter Damian** (1007 - 1072) was a widely respected Italian priest and teacher. In his late twenties he became a hermit & promoted the religious life in many parts of Italy.

22 Feb The Feast of **St Peter's Chair** has been celebrated in Rome since at least the fourth century. It signifies the unity of the Church founded upon the Apostles.

23 Feb **St Polycarp** (- 155) was a disciple of the Apostles, bishop of Smyrna, and a friend of St Ignatius of Antioch. He was martyred in about 155 by being burnt to death. Polycarp is important because he is one of the earliest Christians whose writings still survive.
