FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

28 February **St Oswald** (-992) was a French Benedictine monk who became a Bishop in England in 961 and later became the Archbishop of York. He had a special love of the poor; in Lent he would wash the feet of twelve poor men every day.

1 March **St David** (520 - 589) was abbot and bishop of Cardiff, Wales.

3 March **St Katharine Drexel** (1858 - 1955) Born in the USA she founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, dedicated to working among the poor. She spent her life and her fortune opening schools, a university, and many chapels, convents and monasteries.
