WHAT IS A PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL?

"The early Christian Community remained faithful to the apostles' teaching, to fellowship, to the breaking of bread, to prayer ..." (Acts 2:42)

The **PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL** is a faith-filled leadership group through which priests and people pray and work together as co-responsible partners in furthering the mission of Christ in their own parish.

WHAT DOES IT DO?

- researches the needs in our parish community and then decides on priorities.
- puts together a realistic plan at the beginning of each year. This can be reviewed at the end of the year. Using 'SMART' goals will help you (Specific, Measureable, Attainable, Relevant, Time-Based)
- It formulates a Mission Statement that describes the mission of the parish, (not that of the Pastoral Council).
- It reviews and improves our parish's communication strategy.
- It seeks to 'put everything into a missionary key' ('Evangelii Gaudium') as Pope Francis has encouraged us to do.
- It looks at the various ways of nourishing and supporting the faith of parishioners at different stages of their lives.

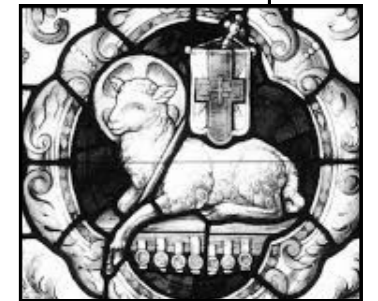

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

15 Jan **ST ITA** (c.475 - 570) was born in Co. Waterford and founded a community of women in Killeedy, Co. Limerick. She was known for her holiness and for her gift of prophecy.

17 Jan **ST ANTHONY**, Abbot (251 - 356) was the originator of the monastic life. He listened to the words of the Gospel and gave all he had to the poor. He went out into the wilderness to begin a life of poverty, prayer and meditation. He suffered and overcame many physical and spiritual temptations. Many followers were attracted by his wisdom and holiness.

21 Jan **ST AGNES**, Virgin & Martyr (- 304) All that is known about her life is that, from an early age, she was filled with the love of God and was killed because of her Christian faith.
