

St Thomas Aquinas (1225 - 1274) Italian Dominican friar, philosopher & theologian. **St Angela Merici** was born in Italy in 1474. She founded the Ursuline Sisters, the first teaching congregation of women. She died on 27 January 1540.

St Aidan (550 - 626) an Irish monk and missionary, was born in Cavan and taught by St David in Wales.

Blessed Margaret Ball was born in Skryne, Co. Meath in 1515. She was martyred in 1584 for helping spread the Catholic faith.
