## FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

5 July St Antony Mary Zaccaria (1502 - 1539) was born in Lombardy. He was studying medicine, but thenn decided to become a priest. He was part of the movement to self reform in a Church that was responding to the Protestant Reformation.

5 July The Wexford Martyrs were executed for their Catholic faith in 1581. 6 July St Maria Goretti (1890 - 1902) is one of the youngest saints to be canonized. She died after being attacked by a young man she knew. Before she died, Maria forgave her attacker and promised to pray for him. She is honoured as the patron saint of Catholic Youth, Girls & Teenagers.

7 July St Maelruain (- c.791) founded the monastery at Tallaght, in Dublin. Together with St Aengus he wrote a detailed Rule for the community, which is an important document in the history of early monasticism.

8 July St Kilian was born in Cavan. He was a missionary Bishop who was killed in 689. 9 July St Augustine Zhao Rong and 119 of his companions were martyred in China between 1648 and 1930. Augustine Zhao Rong was one of the Chinese soldiers who escorted Bishop John Gabriel Taurin Dufresse to his execution. Moved by his patience, he asked to be baptized, and in due course was sent to the seminary and ordained a priest. He was arrested and savagely tortured. He died in 1815.
