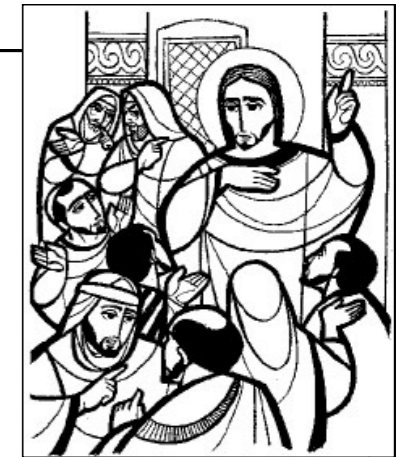

ST MARIA GORETTI (1890 - 6 July 1902) was a kind and helpful 11 year old girl who forgave the man who fatally wounded her when he assaulted her.

ST MAELRUAIN was a Bishop and Abbot, founded the monastery at Tallaght in 769.

ST KILIAN was born in Cavan who preached in north Bavaria and was killed in 689.

ST AUGUSTINE ZHAO RONG was a Chinese soldier who converted to the Christian faith. After being ordained as a priest he was arrested and tortured. He died in 1815.

His companions were 119 of the many Chinese martyrs were killed from 1648 - 1930

ST BENEDICT (480 - 547) was the author of the Rule of St Benedict, which was a set of rules that guided nuns and monks on how to live in their communities.
