FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

8 July **St Kilian** was born in Cavan. He preached in north Bavaria and was killed in 689.
11 July **St Benedict** (480 - 543) monk, wrote a Rule for monasteries that civilized Europe.
13 July **St Henry** (973-1024) was born in Bavaria and as Holy Roman Emperor he supported the reform of the Church.
14 July **St Camillus de Lellis** (1550 - 1614) an Italian soldier who at the age of 25 devoted his life to caring for the sick spiritually and physically. He founded the Servants of the Sick (the Camillians), a congregation of priests and lay brothers.
