**MOYNALVEY KILTALE FIRST RESPONDER
GROUP** A Cardiac First Responder is a
person trained to a minimum basic level of
basic life support in CPR and the use of an
AED/defibrillator who attends to assist in an
actual or potentially life threatening
emergency such as a cardiac arrest, heart
attack, stroke or choking.

After an accident Community First
Responder groups provide the first response
before the arrival of the emergency services.
Community First Responder groups receive
formal training and sign up to a programme
with the National Ambulance Service to
provide an immediate response in their area.

provided. We are also hoping to purchase 2
Defibrillators to help us to provide basic life
support in this area in actual or potentially

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

20 June **THE IRISH MARTYRS** honours the men and women, clerical and lay, who were put
to death for their faith between 1579 and 1654. The word Martyr in its original meaning
meant 'witness'. Over time it was the term given to those people who were willing to give
witness to their faith even unto death. During the 16th and 17th centuries in Ireland the
Catholic Religion was under persecution and many people made the ultimate sacrifice.
In 1992 17 of these martyrs were formally declared 'Blessed' by Pope John Paul II.
21 June **ST ALOYSIUS**' (1568-1591) father wanted him to be a soldier. Aloysius chose to
become a Jesuit priest. He died caring for the sick when a plague broke out in Rome.
