FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

5 June **St Boniface** (675- 754) English Benedictine monk who spread the faith in Germany
6 June **St Jarlath** (445-550) the first Bishop and patron saint of the Archdiocese of Tuam.
7 June **St Colman** was the first Bishop of Dromore (Co. Down) in the 5th century.
9 June **St Columba** (521-597) was born in Donegal and is one of the three patron saints of
Ireland along with St Patrick and St Brigid. He founded monasteries in Ireland & Scotland.
9 June **St Ephraem** (306-373) from Syria was a composer of wonderful hymns & homilies.
11 June **St Barnabas** was born in Cyprus. He was one of the early Christian converts in
Jerusalem and accompanied St Paul on his first missionary journey. He went to Cyprus
with his cousin of St Mark the evangelist to preach the gospel there. He was probably
martyred at Salamis in Cyprus, some time before the year 61.
