### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

11 June **ST BARNABAS** was born in Cyprus and was one of the early Christian converts in Jerusalem. He accompanied St Paul on his first missionary journey. He went to Cyprus with his cousin St Mark the Evangelist and was probably martyred there around the year 61.  
13 June **ST ANTHONY OF PADUA** (1195 - 1231) was an Augustinian monk who was so impressed by the martyrdom of five Franciscans who had been spreading the faith in Morocco that he became a Franciscan friar. In 1221 he met Saint Francis of Assisi. He was a brilliant preacher and the first Franciscan theologian. He is patron saint of the lost & found.  
14 June **ST DAVNET** lived the parish of Tydavnet ("house of Davnet"), Co. Monaghan. She founded a monastery there in the 6th century & is the patron saint of the diocese of Clogher.
