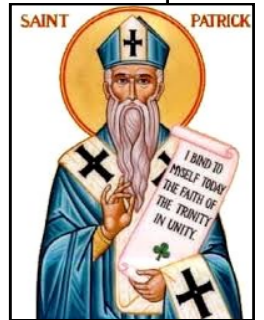

19 March **St Joseph** - HUSBAND OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - Nothing is known of St Joseph except what is said of him in the Gospels. He was a carpenter. He accepted the will of God; and he supported Mary and brought up Jesus.  
21 March **St Enda** (- 530) founded a monastery on the island of Aran Mór in Galway Bay.  
23 March **St Turibius of Mongrovejo** (1538 - 1606) was born in Spain. As bishop of Lima, Peru. He made the Church there holy; and he defended the rights of the natives.
