FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

22 March **St Deogratias** (d. 457) was an outstanding priest, very much loved and supported by the people because of his charity and preaching. During his ministry as bishop of Carthage he cared for all the people, especially for the many captives that had been taken to Northern Africa by the Vandal king Genseric. Bishop Deogratias was a pastoral leader, full of love for his people and ready to respond to their practical and spiritual needs.

23 March **St Turibius of Mongrovejo** (1538 - 1606) was born in Spain. He was named bishop of Lima in 1580 and sailed to America. He traversed his gigantic diocese three times, generally on foot, baptizing, teaching and confirming the natives. He worked to make the Church strong, organised, and above all holy; and he strongly defended the rights of the natives, who were Spanish citizens according to the law but who were nevertheless being oppressed by the colonists and the provincial governors.

24 March **St Macartan** (- 506) was converted from paganism by his friend St Patrick. He became bishop of Clogher.

27 March **St John of Egypt** (304 - 394) was a hermit who devoted himself to prayer and manual work. He was able to heal the sick and read people's hearts. Even when St John became famous, he remained humble and did not lead an easy life. He knew that his life of self-sacrifice would help him stay close to God.
