**“WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF WE TREATED

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

27 March **St John of Egypt** (304 - 394) was a hermit who devoted himself to prayer and
manual work. He was able to heal the sick and read people's hearts. Even when St John
became famous, he remained humble and did not lead an easy life. He never ate before
sunset. St John knew that his life of self-sacrifice would help him stay close to God.

1 April **St Ceallach** (1080 - 1129) became hereditary bishop of Armagh in 1105 and made
many reforms; not least on his deathbed, when he abolished the hereditary principle by
appointing St Malachy as his successor.
