MAKE HOLY WEEK MORE MEANINGFUL

- Don't watch television from sundown on Holy Thursday until Easter morning.
- Make it a point to Forgive someone on Good Friday.
- Go to Confessions
- Pray the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
- Pray the Stations of the Cross.
- Go to all of the Triduum liturgies.

The word “Triduum” comes from the Latin word meaning “three days,” It takes in the three most sacred days in the Church year. It begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, reaches a high point at the Easter Vigil, and concludes at sundown on Easter Sunday.

PEOPLE HAVE TWO SIDES: that which we offer to outsiders (‘we tell our triumphs to the crowds’) and what we try to keep strictly to ourselves – our heartaches and failures (our hearts are the sole confidants of our sorrows.) We are entering Holy Week when the crowds initially welcomed Jesus into the city. Soon they will change dramatically and want him destroyed. The ‘triumph’ of Palm Sunday quickly yields to the pain and loneliness of the garden of Gethsemane. We each carry our successes and failures, our ups and our downs. In Jesus we have a brother who has travelled this path for us. We will learn from him this week.
