Jesus called him directly. 3 May **St James** is known as the 'son of Alphaeus' and we know very little about him. 4 May St Conleth (450-519) is the patron saint of Newbridge, Co Kildare. He was a metal-worker in silver and gold who had a hermitage there. St Brigid called him to assist her at her monastery in Kildare and to be its bishop. 5 May Blessed Edmund Rice (1762 - 1844) was born in Co. Kilkenny. He founded the Congregation of Christian Brothers and the Presentation Brothers.
