13 May **OUR LADY OF FATIMA** commemorates the visions of Our Lady seen near Fatima, Portugal, in 1917 by three shepherd children.

14 May **ST MATTHIAS**, Apostle. Chosen to replace Judas Iscariot after his treachery & death

15 May **ST CARTHAGE** (555 - 637) was abbot of Rahan, Co. Offaly, and founder and first abbot of Lismore, Co. Waterford.

15 May **ST ISIDORE** (1070 - 1130) is the patron of farmers and rural communities.

16 May **ST BRENDAN OF CLONFERT** (484 - 577) was called "the Navigator".

18 May **POPE ST JOHN 1** was born in Italy, elected Pope in 523 and martyred in 526.
