FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

22 May **ST RITA OF CASCIA** (1377 - 1447) was born in Italy. Married at the age of 12, she
become a nun after her husband was killed. Patron saint of impossible or lost causes.
25 May **ST BEDE THE VENERABLE** (673 - 735) an English monk, historian & theologian.
25 May **POPE ST GREGORY VII** (1020 - 1085) was one of the great Church reformers. On
being elected as Pope the first thing he did was to spend many days in prayer. He also asked
others to pray for him. He knew that without prayer nothing can be done well for God.
25 May **ST MARY MAGDALENE DE PAZZI** (1566 - 1607) was an Italian Carmelite nun.
26 May **ST PHILIP NERI** (1515 - 1595) priest & founder of the Congregation of the Oratory.
27 May **ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY** (-604) Monk & founder of the English Church.
