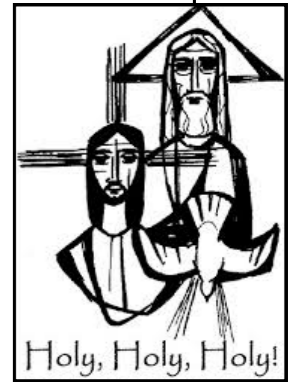

22 May **ST RITA OF CASCIA** (1377 - 1447) was born in Italy. Married at the age of 12 she become a nun after her husband was killed. Patron saint of impossible or lost causes
25 May **ST BEDE THE VENERABLE** (673 - 735) an English monk, historian & theologian.
25 May **POPE ST GREGORY VII** (1020 - 1085) was one of the great Church reformers.
25 May **ST MARY MAGDALENE DE PAZZI** (1566 - 1607) was a Carmelite nun who led a life of prayer and self-denial.
26 May **ST PHILIP NERI** (1515 - 1595) priest & founder of the Congregation of the Oratory.
27 May **ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY** (-604) a monk & founder of the English Church.
