THE BEATIFICATION OF ARCHBISHOP

OSCAR ROMERO - SATURDAY 23 MAY

Archbishop Romero was a courageous and inspirational leader who used his conviction of faith and his position as Archbishop to defend and protect the weakest members of society. He was an outspoken champion of the powerless and the poor, and was ultimately murdered for his unflinching defence of human rights. Archbishop Romero once said that if he was killed he would rise again in the people. Today, people in El Salvador and throughout Central America continue to put themselves at huge personal risk in order to continue his mission. The beatification of Archbishop Romero is not only a fitting tribute to his own work, it is also a powerful message of solidarity to those who continue to put their lives at risk to speak out against injustice and human rights violations in Central America, and indeed throughout the world.

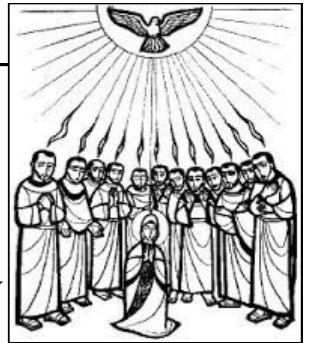
