FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

27 May ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY (-604) was chosen by Pope Gregory to lead a group of monks who were sent to S.E. England to spread the Gospel there. 30 May ST JOAN OF ARC (1412-1432) After St Michael the Archangel appeared to her in a vision St Joan led the French army to victories against the English in the 100Years' War. She was burned at the stake after a politically-motivated trial, and was canonized in 1920. 1 June ST JUSTIN was a philosopher who defended the teachings of the church and was executed in 165 by the emperor Marcus Aurelius for being a Christian. 2 June ST MARCELLINUS & ST PETER were martyred by the emperor Diocletian in 304.
