FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

10 May - **ST COMGALL** (510/520 - 597/602) was the founder and abbot of the great Irish monastery at Bangor, Northern Ireland.

12 May - **SAINTS NEREUS AND ACHILLEUS**, Martyrs, were Roman soldiers who became Christians. They refused to serve any longer, and were therefore executed. They were buried in Rome, in the catacomb of St Domitilla.

13 May - The Feast of **OUR LADY OF FÁTIMA** commemorates the visions of Our Lady seen near Fátima in Portugal in 1917 by three shepherd children, Lúcia dos Santos and her cousins Jacinta and Francisco Marto. The visions occurred on the 13th day of each month from May to October, and by October huge crowds were gathering at the site of the visions and reporting visions and miraculous occurrences themselves. Pope John Paul II was devoted to Our Lady of Fátima and attributed his survival of an assassin's bullet on 13 May 1981 to her intervention. Jacinta and Francisco Marto, who died in the great Spanish Flu pandemic of 1919-20, were beatified on 13 May 2000.

14 May - **ST MATTHIAS**, Apostle, was not one of the Twelve; but after the treachery and death of Judas Iscariot, someone was needed to take his place. Two candidates were selected, and lots were drawn to see which of them should be made one of the Twelve: the choice fell on Matthias. Nothing is known for certain about his subsequent history.

15 May - **ST CARTHAGE** (c.555 - 637) is also known as Mochuda. He was born in Kerry. After being a swineherd he joined a monastery and was ordained a priest. In 580 he determined to lead a hermit's life, but after a few years his hermitage had become a place of pilgrimage and he was expelled from it by the local abbots or bishops. He settled at Rahan near Tullamore and in 590 set up a monastery, composing a rule for his monks to follow. In 635 he founded a new monastery at Lismore, and was the first bishop of the town that grew up round it.
