The Irish Synodal Pathway: What is Discernment?

Spiritual discernment is at the core of the Irish synodal pathway. Discernment is an intentional practice of becoming aware of and understanding the Lord's voice. As Pope Francis highlighted, synodal discernment is an exercise in "giving the microphone to the Holy Spirit". Throughout the Irish synodal journey, quiet awareness, self-examination, and patient discernment were used extensively. Last year the Meath Diocesan Synod Team offered five sessions across the diocese for Parish Pastoral Councils to train them in a method for discernment called Conversation in the Spirit. This approach helps support authentic, prayerful listening and decision making so as to discern together what God is saying.

National Novena to Our Lady of Knock 13 – 21 August 2026

Since 1977, the National Novena to Our Lady of Knock has taken place at Knock Shrine, welcoming pilgrims from across Ireland and abroad to gather in prayer and reflection. This year's theme, "Sheltered in God's Love," marks the 50th anniversary of the opening of Knock Basilica and reflects its continuing role as a place of faith, hope and community for all who visit this sacred place.
