Lent

The season of Lent commences this coming Wednesday with mass and distribution of ashes. Lent is the Christian season of prayer, penance and fasting. The ashes given out by tradition are placed on the forehead, reminding us of our mortality, and also the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Ash Wednesday is one of the two fasting days in the catholic calendar – the other being Good Friday. Catholics are required to abstain from meat on Wednesday (one meal and two colations).

During this Lenten Season weekday masses on **Wednesday's will be held at 7pm in Kiltale**, with the Stations of the Cross at 6.45pm, and on **Friday's at 7pm in Moynalvey**, with the Stations of the Cross at 6.45pm. There will be no morning masses on those days.

Prayer for Ash Wednesday

God our Father, on the day of Baptism we were claimed for Christ our Saviour by the sign of his Cross. On this Ash Wednesday, we come before you, desiring to fulfil our baptismal promises, by dying to selfishness and by living for Christ.
