The Irish Synodal Pathway: What is “the Synod”?

When people mention "the Synod" in the Catholic Church today, it refers to a multi-year global initiative launched by Pope Francis in 2021 called the “*Synod on Synodality*”. In 2025 Pope Leo XIV stated, on the day he was elected, “We want to be a synodal Church”. The purpose of the Irish Synodal Pathway is not to rewrite church teaching; rather it is to discover together what God is asking of the Church in Ireland at this time and make progress towards fulfilling that. Over the next six weeks, the Meath Diocesan Synod Team will offer this series in your parish bulletin designed to strip away the complex jargon and explain key aspects of this journey in our diocese, as we prepare for the historic National Synodal Assembly this October.: www.dioceseofmeath.ie/synod
