Go to Confession – Be in a state of grace, free from attachment to sin. **Receive Holy Communion** – Ideally on the same day as the pilgrimage or prayer.

Perform an act of mercy or penance – Such as helping someone in need, visiting the sick or lonely, or offering acts of charity.

Those unable to travel due to illness or age can still receive the indulgence by joining spiritually, praying at home, and uniting their suffering with Christ.

This Jubilee is a time of grace, renewal, and deepened faith. Let us embrace this opportunity to draw closer to God's mercy and live out the works of charity.
