Dunboyne Parish Mission

Dunboyne Parish wish to invite you to a Parish Mission they are hosting from Sunday, 23rd November to Friday, 28th November to close the jubilee Year of Hope. The theme for the Parish mission is “Come and See – A Message of Hope.” All Welcome.

Role of the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) as Defined by Meath Diocese

A parish is a community of the Christian faithful established within a particular church, the pastoral care of which is entrusted to a Parish Priest or Administrator. The PPC, therefore, is a faith-filled, **consultative body of the faithful**, through which priests and parishioners work together as co-responsible partners in furthering the mission of Christ in their own parish. The PPC is a CONSULTATIVE body responsible to the Parish Priest or Administrator who in turn is responsible to the Bishop (See Canon 536). Therefore, the primary concern of the PPC is promoting PASTORAL ACTION, **not Administration, Buildings, Asset Management, Finance, Appointment of Staff**, all of which are the responsibility of the Bishop, the Parish Priest and other groups in the parish.

Areas of Focus for the PPC may include:

1. Liturgy, worship, sacramental preparation, and prayer life of the parish
2. Faith formation, catechesis, evangelization, scripture, renewal programmes
3. Outreach to lapsed Catholics, ‘new seekers’, ethnic groups, Visitors in the Parish
4. Promoting vocations to the priesthood and religious life
5. Supporting family life
6. Proclamation of God’s word
7. Social outreach to those on the margins, those in difficulties etc.
8. Pastoral care of the sick, the bereaved, those in hospital, the dying
9. Youth ministry and outreach
10. Environmental action – care of our common home
11. Ecumenism
12. Supporting safeguarding culture in the parish
13. Pastoral planning and parish policy making.
