### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

17 Nov **St Elizabeth of Hungary** (1207-1231) was a princess of Hungary. She was widowed at 20. After her husband's death she devoted herself to the poor and built the sick.  
22 Nov **St Cecelia** was an early Christian martyr about whom very little is known.  
23 Nov **St Columbanus** (543-615) was an Irish missionary monk who founded a number of monasteries in southern France and north Italy.  
24 Nov **St Andrew Dong Lac** (1795-1839) was a Vietnamese priest ordained in 1823 and executed in 1839 during the persecution under Minh Mang. His feast day also honours all **the Vietnamese Martyrs** of the 17th to the 19th centuries.
