CATHOLICS AND CREMATION

What should become of the cremated remains following the funeral?

Church teaching insists that cremated remains must be given the same respect as the body, including the manner in which they are carried and the attention given to their appropriate transport and placement. The cremated remains of a body are to be buried or entombed, in a Catholic cemetery, and using the rites provided by the Order of Christian Funerals. The following are not considered to be reverent dispositions that the Church requires: scattering cremated remains, dividing cremated remains and keeping cremated remains in the home. The remains of a cremated body should be treated with the same respect given to the corporeal remains of a human body. This includes a worthy container to hold the cremated remains.

KEEP LEFT IN KILTALE - A suggestion to deal with the narrow central aisle in Kiltale is to ask those coming forward to receive Communion to keep to their left coming up, choose who to receive from when they are near the top of the aisle, and then return down keeping to their left once more.

COELIACS WHO WISH TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION UNDER THE FORM OF A COELIAC HOST are welcome to do so and should make themselves known to the priest or sacristan.
