### THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Pope Pius XI established the Feast of Christ  
the King when he published his encyclical  
"Quas primas" on 11 December 1925 -  
almost 90 years ago. The Feast and the  
encyclical were in response to the growing  
violence and nationalism which, in time, led  
to the horrors of Nazism and Stalinism. Pius  
XI wanted to offer to the world the vision of  
the Kingdom of God, where Christ is King,  
as an alternative to hatred and bloodshed.  
In many ways, our present experience in  
Europe makes the Feast and encyclical very  
resonant. It was Pope Pius XI who proposed  
to Bishop Mulvany that the new cathedral in  
Mullingar be dedicated to Christ the King.

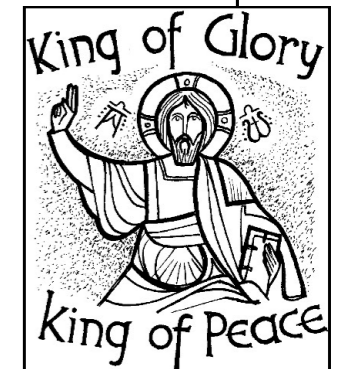

### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

23 Nov **ST COLUMBANUS** (543-615) was an Irish missionary monk who founded a  
number of monasteries in southern France and north Italy.

24 Nov **ST ANDREW DUNG-LAC** (1795-1839) was a Vietnamese priest ordained in  
1823 and executed in 1839 during the persecution under Minh Mang. His feast day  
also honours all of the Vietnamese Martyrs of the 17th to the 19th centuries.

25 Nov **ST COLMAN** (522 - 600) was a bishop who founded several churches in Cork

27 Nov **ST FERGAL** (700 - 784) was an Irishman who lived in France for a number  
of years and later became Abbot of St Peter's at Salzburg.
