### NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS

From 1 November until 8 November, all who have Confession, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 Nov. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 to 8 Nov.
