POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR OCTOBER

1. UNIVERSAL INTENTION

Human Trafficking. That human trafficking,
the modern form of slavery, may be
eradicated.

Slavery is not some ancient historical
practice human beings outgrew; slavery is
rampant today.

According to the Global Slavery Index, over
30 million people around the world are
slaves. Seventy-eight percent are enslaved
for labour and 22 percent for sex. The
country with the highest percentage of slaves
is Mauritania, Africa, at 4 percent. In India
over 14 million people are enslaved. In the
U.S., more than 60,000 people are enslaved.
Pope Francis called human trafficking a
"crime against humanity" and "an open
wound on the body of contemporary society,
a scourge upon the body of Christ."

2. EVANGELISATION INTENTION

Mission in Asia. That with a missionary
spirit the Christian communities of Asia may
announce the Gospel to those who are still
awaiting it. As we pray this month for Asian
missionaries, let us commit ourselves to
being missionaries in our own daily lives.
May the joy and peace our faith gives us

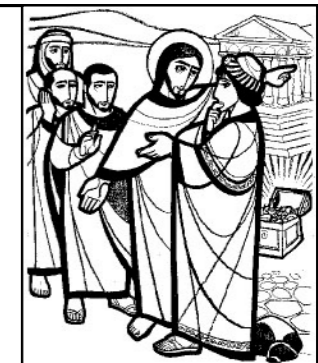

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

11 Oct **St Canice** (516-600) He is one of the Twelve Apostles of Ireland. In 543 he became a pupil at Finian's monastic school at Clonard. Twelve students who studied under St Finian became known as the Twelve Apostles of Ireland. It was at Clonard that he became a friend and companion of St Colmcille (Columba). He founded a monastery in Aghaboe (Co. Laois) and may also have founded one in Kilkenny.
11 Oct **Pope John XXIII** (1881-1963) the "founder" of the Second Vatican Council.
15 Oct **St Teresa of Avila** (1515-1582) was a woman of prayer, a woman for God and an active reformer of herself and the Carmelite Order.
