FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

16 Oct **St Margaret Mary Alacoque** (1647 - 1690) In many Irish churches you will see a stained glass window depicting Our Lord Jesus revealing his Sacred Heart to St Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun who was one of the Church's most famous visionaries.

18 Oct **St Luke the Evangelist** was a Greek doctor who converted to Christianity. He was a friend of St Paul. As well as his Gospel St Luke also wrote the Acts of the Apostles.

19 Oct **Saints John de Brébeuf, Isaac Jogues and Companions** were 8 Jesuits, who were killed by the native Huron and Iroquois tribes in N. America between 1642 and 1649.
