FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

23 Oct St John of Capistrano (1386 - 1456) Italian judge who became a Franciscan priest 27 Oct **St Otteran** was abbot of Meath and later went to Iona. He died in 548 and his grave on Iona was greatly revered. As a result the Vikings chose Otteran, the titular guardian of their ancestors' ashes, as patron of the city of Waterford in 1096.

28 Oct St Simon the Apostle was also known as "the Zealot." St Jude the Apostle was also known as Thaddeus. He is the patron saint of lost and desperate causes.

29 Oct **St Colman Mac Duagh** (560 - 632) Bishop & abbot. He was the son of an Irish Chieftain. He was born in Galway and was the founder of the monastery at Kilmacduagh.
