As we approach November and the end of the Church year our focus begins to turn towards remembering and praying for the dead. We remember our Dead when we enter their names on the **ALTAR LIST OF THE DEAD** so that they can be prayed for at Mass to help them attain their eternal rest. List of the Dead envelopes are in your box of envelopes or will be available from both churches. Masses on First Fridays during the year and on All Souls Day are offered for the Parish List of the Dead.

WHAT ARE INDULGENCES?

Indulgences are the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been given. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the Saints.

NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE FEAST OF ALL SOULS

1. From 12 noon on 1 Nov until midnight on 2 Nov, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 Nov to 8 Nov.

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1 to 8 Nov. The conditions mentioned above apply also to this.

ST SIMON & ST JUDE Apart from their names in the Gospel, there is very little we know definitely about these two Apostles. There is a tradition that Simon got as far as Britain, perhaps Glastonbury, and was martyred in Lincolnshire. According to another tradition Simon joined up with Jude to preach the Gospel in Persia, where they died a martyr's death. **ST COLMAN MAC DUAGH** (560 to 632) Bishop & abbot, He was the son of the Irish Chieftain. He was born in Galway and was the founder of the monastery at Kilmacduagh.
