### FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

19 Sept: **St Januarius** was an Italian Bishop who was martyred in the 4th century.  
20 Sept: **St Andrew Kim Tae-gon & companions** 103 Korean Martyrs who were put to death between 1791 and 1866.  
21 Sept: **St Matthew**, Apostle and Gospel writer, was a Jew who worked for the occupying Roman forces, collecting taxes from other Jews. He would have been hated by other Jews. So it was shocking to them to hear Jesus call him to be one of his closest followers.  
23 Sept: **St Eunan** (628-704) A Columban monk who was abbot (Bishop) of Iona.  
23 Sept: **St Pio of Pietrelcina** (1887-1968) Italian Capuchin priest known as Padre Pio.
