25 Sept: **St Finbarr** (550-620) Bishop of Cork & now patron of Cork city & county.
26 Sept: **St Cosmas & St Dmaian** (283) are buried in Syria but little is known about them
27 Sept: **St Vincent de Paul** (1581-1660) French priest & founder of the Sisters of Charity
28 Sept: **St Lawrence Ruiz** was the first Filipino martyr in 1637.
29 Sept: **Ss Michael, Gabriel & Raphael** - Archangels - messengers from God. Each one
performs a different mission - Michael protects; Gabriel announces; Raphael guides.
1 Oct: **St Thérèse of the Child Jesus**, Virgin, Doctor (1873 - 1897) was a French
Carmelite nun who lived each day with an unshakable confidence in God's love.
