8 Sept: **St Leo the Great** (- 461) became Pope in 440. He was "a true shepherd of souls."
9 Sept: **St Ciarán** (512-545) was born in Roscommon. He founded a monastery in Clonmacnoise which would become famous all over Europe as a place of learning.
12 Sept: **St Ailbe** founded a monastery in Emilly which became an important place of learning in Munster. He died in 528.
13 Sept: **St John Chrysostom** (349-407) was a great preacher and writer from Turkey.
14 Sept: **The Triumph of the Cross** celebrates the recovery of the Holy Cross in 629 by Emperor Heraclius from the Persians, who had taken it after it was discovered by St Helena
